# Rutherglen bug

## Management Recommendations

---

- Monitor your canola and weeds when planting summer crops nearby. Ensure you are dealing with Rutherglen bug and not Grey cluster bug (see identification page).
- Remove canola trash and consider digging a trench at the field edge to avoid nymph movement from canola into summer crops.
- Manage weeds in surrounding crops and non-crop habitat, especially fleabane.
- Plant summer crops early.
